



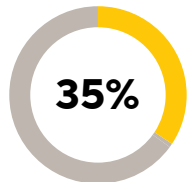

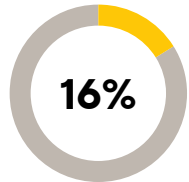

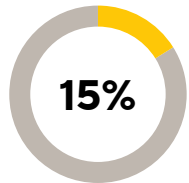
% BREAKDOWN OF

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION



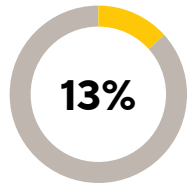

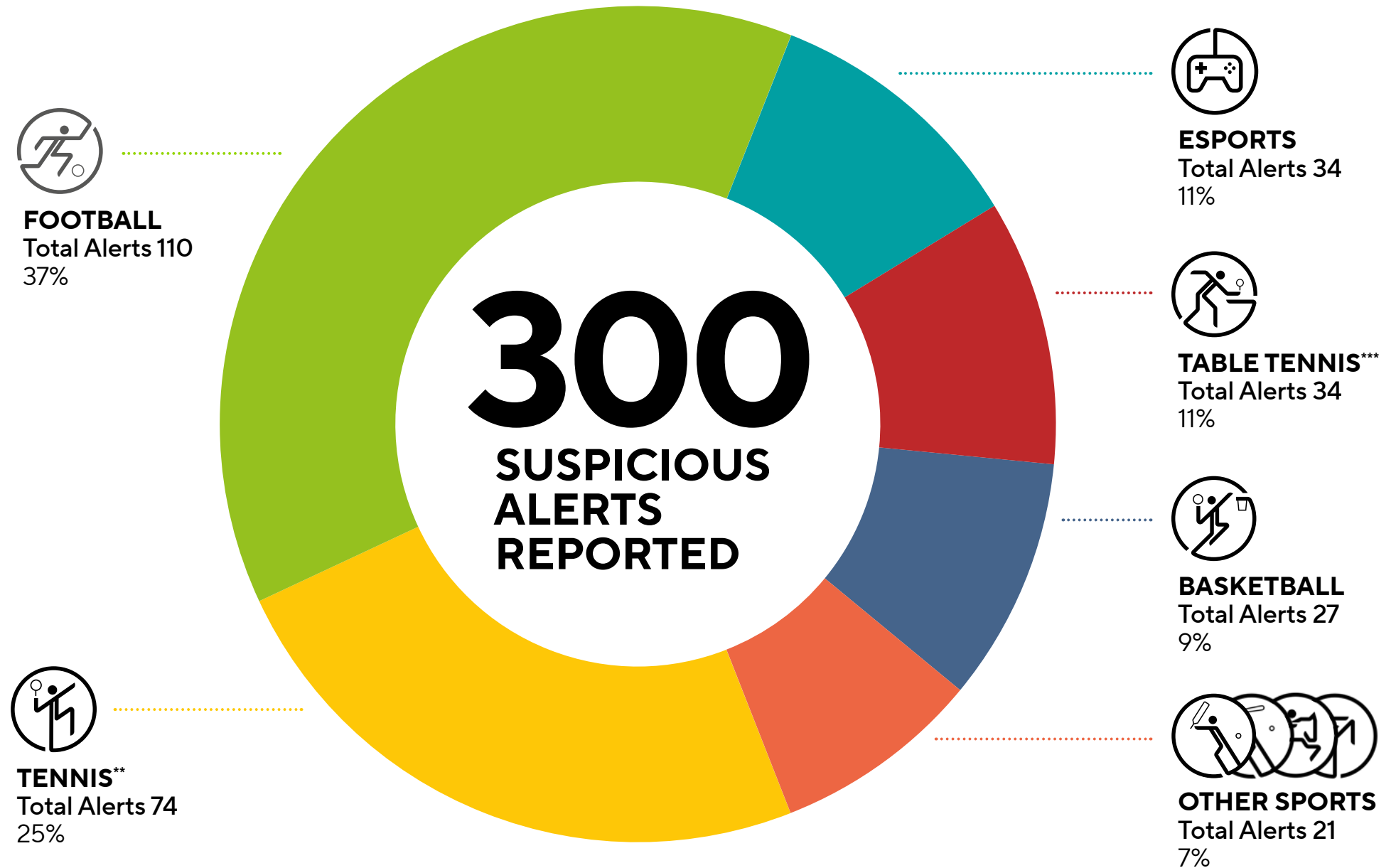
ALERTS

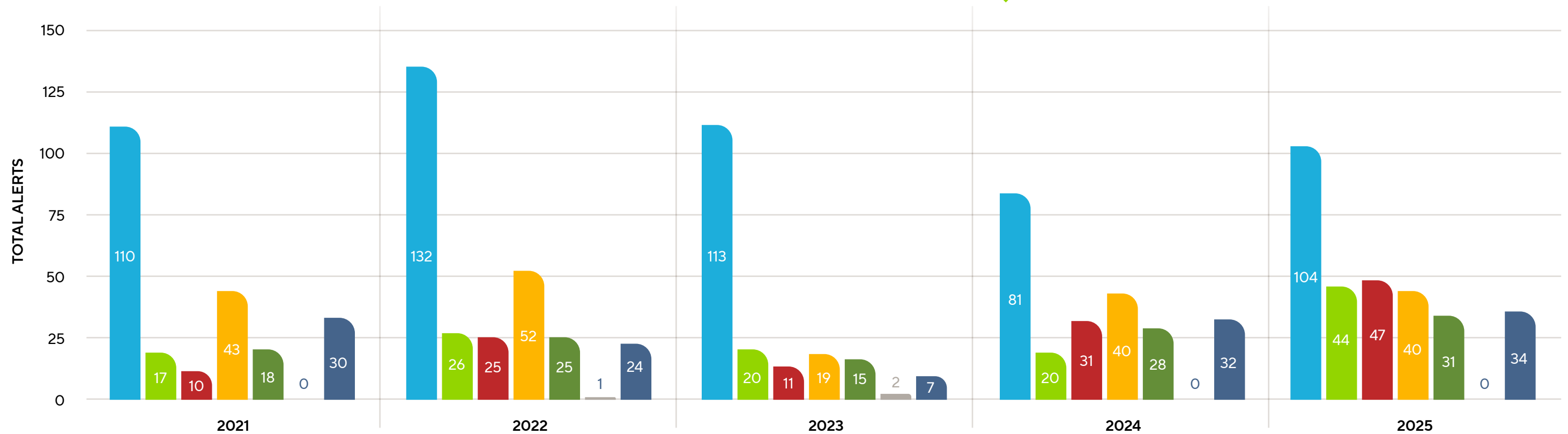

Total Alerts by Geographical Location

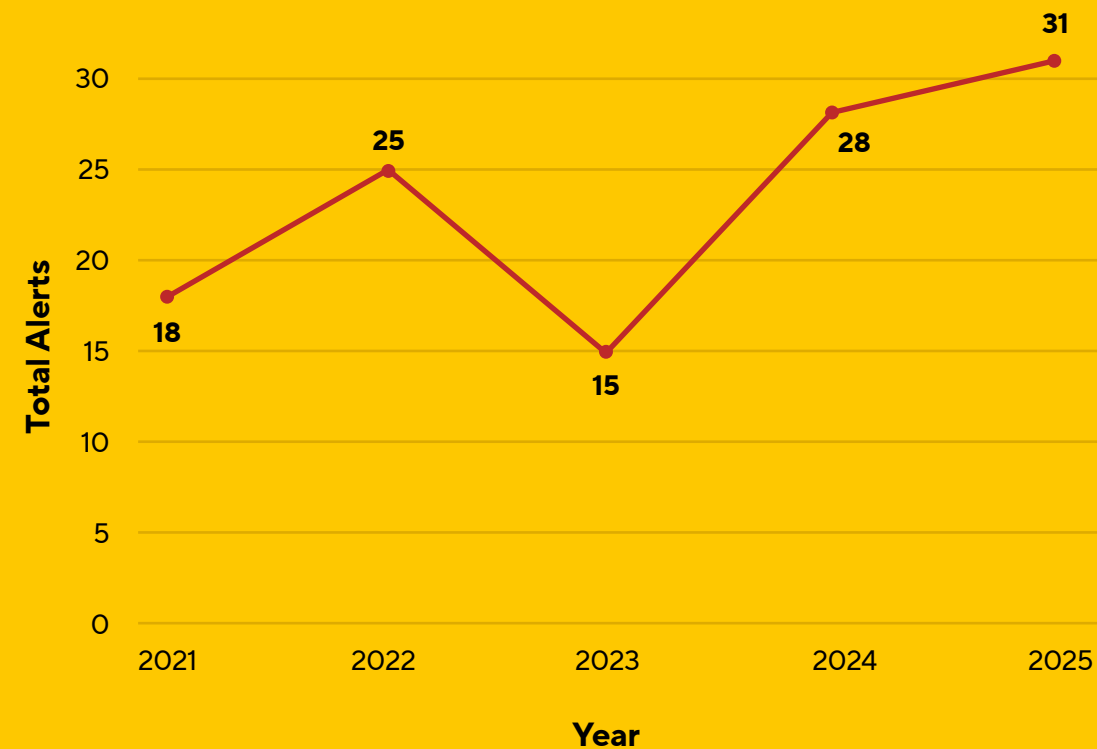

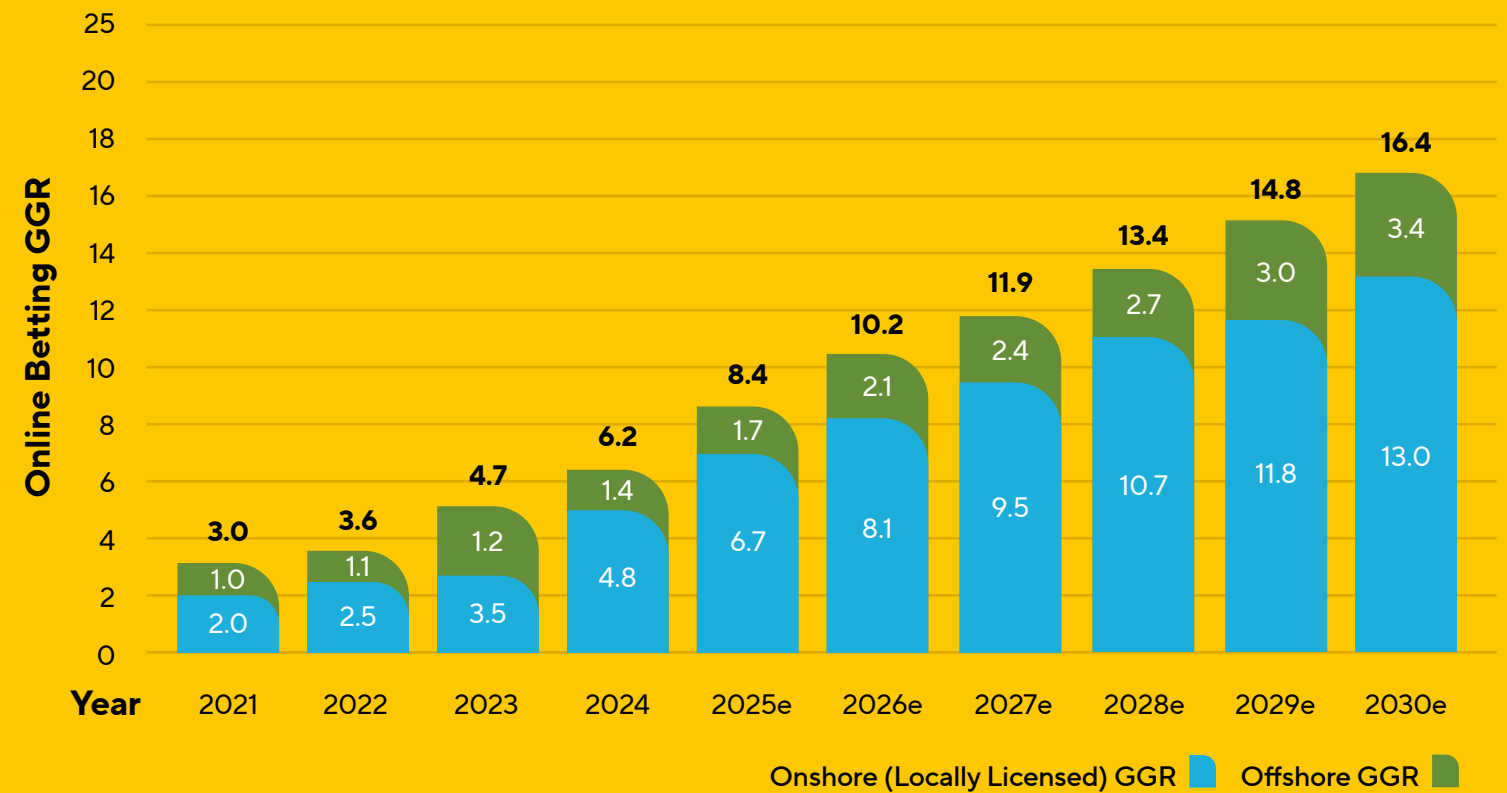
Suspicious Alerts Reported

From 2021 to 2025, IBIA reported 117 suspicious betting alerts across African sporting events, primarily involving football (67) and tennis (42).



Online Betting GGR (US\$bn)

Africa's total betting gross gambling revenue (GGR) is projected to grow from US\$3.5bn in 2021 to US\$19.4bn by 2030. The majority of this growth will be online betting, which is predicted to reach US\$16.4bn by 2030, with US\$13bn (or 79%) placed onshore. Land-based betting GGR is predicted to grow from US\$1.4bn in 2021 to US\$3bn by 2030.

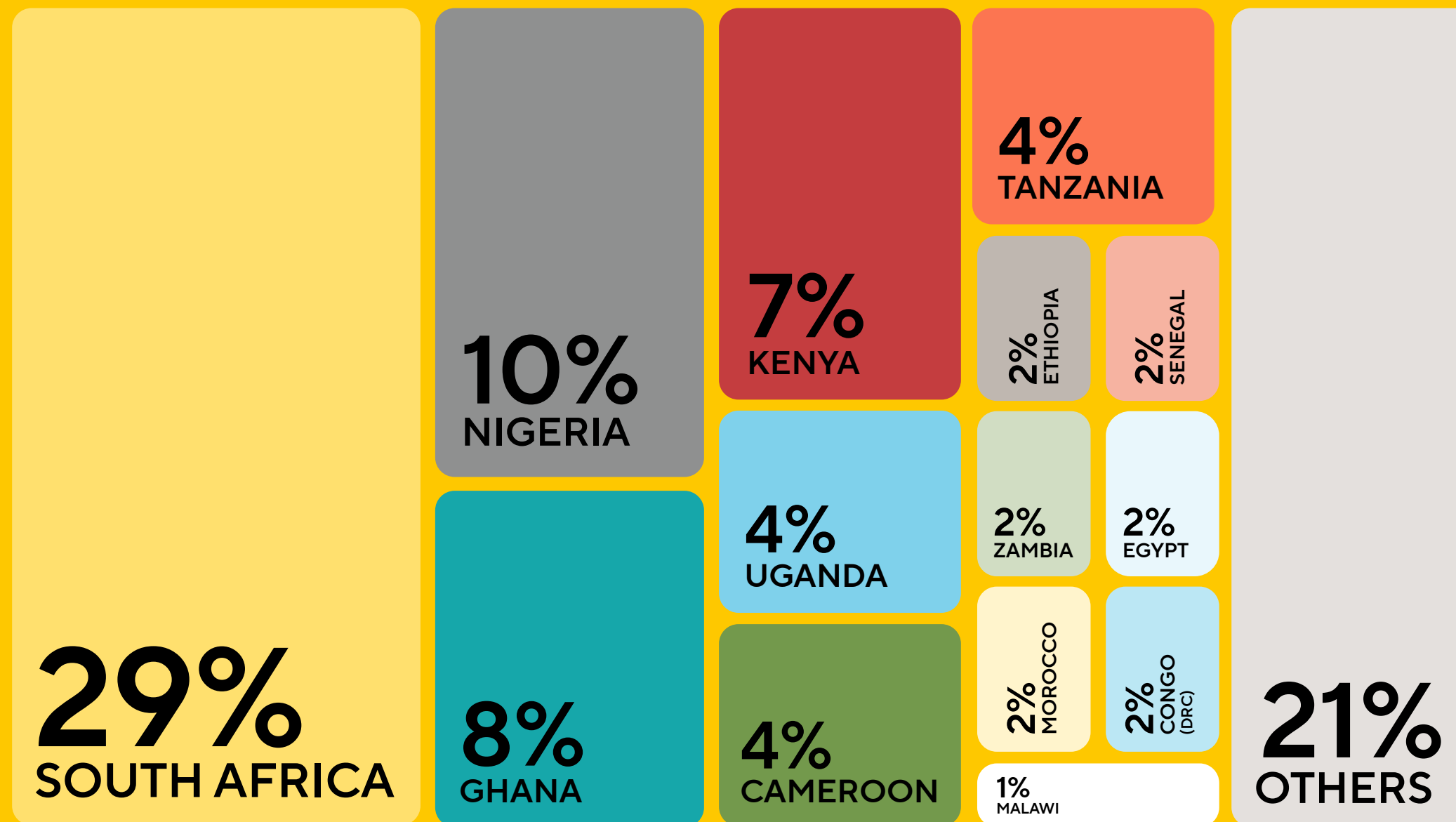
Online Betting GGR by Market

The African betting market is forecast to continue its strong growth, driven by positive macroeconomic and demographic trends.

South Africa, Nigeria and Ghana lead Africa's betting GGR, however it is the smaller markets that are forecast to be a significant growth driver going forward.
